Global Retail Payment Transactions ~ \$21 Trillion




Today, around **85% of all retail payment transactions are done** with cash



Benefit of this Approach

App UI Starter Kits

- ✓ Fully-working app
- ✓ Editable source code

Lower development hurdles, reduce time to market, and improve adoption

Cross-platform SDKs (+docs)

- Drop into app project
- ✓ Familiar syntax

Mobile Backend Server

- ✓ Mobile optimized APIs, domain-specific abstraction layer
- ✓ App-specific services and business logic

APIs Endpoints Only

- **X** Takes time to interpret and implement
- **X** Lacks app-specific mobile services; typically designed for web apps

Lessons Learned: Evolving Developer Ecosystem Needs

You need to meet the needs of mobileenabling a developer ecosystem today...

User Interface "Starter Kit"

- Cross-platform UI code with SDK examples
- non-proprietary, editable source code
- Template starter kits

...with an architecture that accommodates the evolving needs of new devices and endpoints

API Management

- Web services on legacy systems
- Usage and bandwidth throttling
- ✓ Key management
- ✓ SOA governance and policy management
- ✓ API monetization




Happy Developer Ecosystem ✓ Object Relational

Backend Services

- Mapping layer for "composite" apps
- ✓ Cross-platform SDKs
- Mobile-specific business logic
- Mobile services (push, SMS, etc.)
